TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS AT JPLBC

FULL MEMBER.* Full Members have full rights and privileges at Jefferson Park Lawn Bowling Club, allowing them to participate in all club events, vote at official club meetings and serve on the Board. A portion of the Full membership fee is paid to the Northwest Division (NWD) (https://www.bowlsnw.com) and to Bowls USA (BUSA) (https://www.bowlsusa.us).

New members may join anytime throughout the year. The Annual Fee is not pro-rated, however, new members who join after August 1st receive bonus time and are paid in full through Dec 31 the following year. New members who join after August 1st are welcome at all JPLBC social events, club games, leagues and tournaments. They will not be eligible for any national (BUSA) or regional tournaments (NWD, South Central, etc) until the following calendar year. \$125

ASSOCIATE MEMBER. Associate Members have an Full membership at another club. Associate members have full rights and privileges as Full members except they are not entitled to vote or serve on the Board. An Associates' primary club pays the fees to their division and to BUSA. An Associate Member does not have full access to the clubhouse. **\$100**

YOUTH MEMBER. Youth Membership is available to any Bowler under the age of 18 who has a parent, grandparent or guardian who is an Full or Associate member of JPLBC. Youth bowlers must demonstrate the ability to handle bowls and other equipment and to respect the greens. A Youth membership is valid only at JPLBC. If a youth bowler is interested in competitive bowling at a divisional or national tournament, they must pay for a Full or Associate Membership. **\$65**
